Title: Anyone for 'Beating the Bounds' on Sunday 26th May?

Contents:

Beating the Bounds is the ancient annual practice of walking around the Parish boundary on Rogation Sunday - the fifth Sunday after Easter.



Walk leader, CIII Alan Anderson said "It's a primeval way of identifying where one lives, and leads further to questions about one's existence, hence it being done on Rogation Sunday".

"If anybody would like to do the walk this year, we will be leaving from outside **All Saints** at 11am on Sunday 26th May. It would help us to plan the event if you could let us know by Friday 24th May if you're attending, even if that's dependent on the day's weather."

"The walk passes through beautiful countryside, but it also involves a busy road junction, a padlocked gate and private land, so it has to be organised as a group walk."

"It also requires proper footware and provisions (including a packed lunch), as the only facilities on/near the route are Sainsburys after 7 miles, and the whole walk is 9 miles long."
