THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF VARIOUS ROADS IN KINGS LANGLEY DURING THE 'KINGS LANGLEY CHRISTMAS LIGHTS SWITCH ON EVENT') ORDER 2019

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using the following lengths of roads, except for access:-

1. that length of A4251 (High Street/Hempstead Road), Kings Langley from its junction with Langley Hill north westwards to its junction with Common Lane, a distance of approximately 274 metres.

An alternative route will be via A4251 Hempstead Road, Nash Mills Lane, Red Lion Lane, Lower Road, Railway Terrace, Primrose Hill, Station Road, Home Park Mill Link and A4251 (Watford Road/High Street).

2. that length of The Nap, Kings Langley from its junction with A4251 High Road north eastwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event

The sections of roads will be closed between the hours of 12.00midday and 9.00pm on Saturday 30 November 2019, when signs are in place.

The purpose of the Order is to ensure public safety and prevent accidents for the duration of the 'Kings Langley Christmas Lights Switch On Event'.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
