KINGS LANGLEY COMMUNITY AWARDS 2020

COMMUNITY AWARD SCHEME

The aim of the Scheme is to recognise residents who have made an exceptional and valuable contribution to the community in the parish of Kings Langley in the last year or over many years, or be a Kings Langley parish resident who has excelled, attained or realised an exceptional achievement.

Scheme Categories

Improving lives of residents
Action in the Community
Cleaner and greener action
Young Persons
Business in the Community
Lifetime Achievement

There may not always be awards for every category every year as this will depend on nominations. The Lifetime Achievement award will be given only for truly outstanding contribution and will be rarely awarded.

Judging of Awards

An Awards sub-committee will review the nominations and submit their recommendations to full council for approval. The committee will be looking at the following criteria:

What has the nominee done?
How have they done it?
What has been the impact on the village?

Nominations will then be scored as follows:

Lasting or meaningful contribution to the community – 40%
Length and degree of service – 20%
Extent that contribution went above and beyond the norm – 20%
Extent to which the contribution would be recognised and valued by the community – 20%

Lifetime achievement award requires minimum 95% score to preserve its special status.
